Girls group

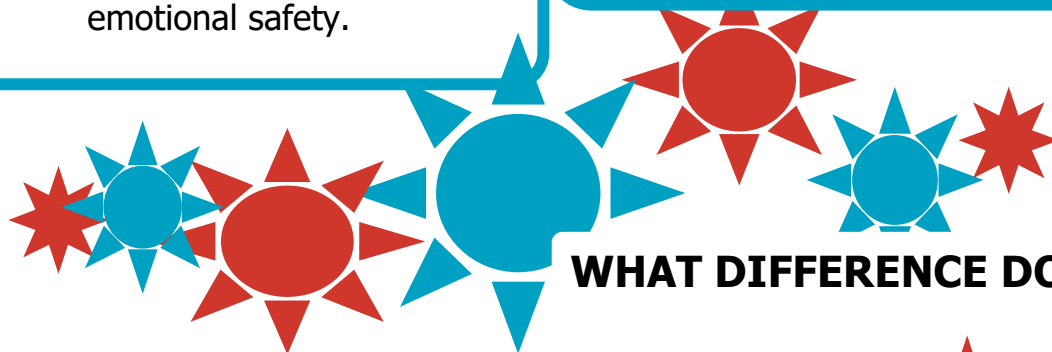
Social capital, self-esteem, self-awareness, self-expression and emotional safety.
